Remove and Install for Maintenance

as Needed

Clean and flush existing gutters and downspouts thoroughly with water prior to installing gutter guard.



1. Slip the back of the screen underneath the shingles so that it rests on top of the hidden gutter hangers



2. Push screen back and snap front lip in.



3. Snap the balance of the screen into place.



4. Push down screen after it is snapped in to ensure screen is fully expanded and lock into place.



5. Repeat with the next piece, overlapping each section to the full depth of the pre-cut notch.



6. For outside corners, cut a 45° angle off the opposite ends of two adjoining pieces. Slide under the shingles and push onto the gutter to form an accurate corner joint.
